#### NOTES

**THE LIPMAN LEDGER:** The Fisher Cats open the Harrisburg on a season-high six-game losing streak after being swept at home by Binghamton. New Hampshire managed just 12 runs in the series and was shut out twice. The team went 5-for-44 (114) with RISP.... Rainer Nunez continues to be a bright spot, hitting .333 (13-39) in July with hits in 10 of his last 11 starts.... Josh Kasevich continues to lead the EL with 92 hits and he has a team-best .289 average.... Starter Trenton Wallace is third in the EL with a 2.76 ERA and second with a .200 average against.... The Fisher Cats are looking for a road series win for the first time since opening weekend at Binghamton. New Hampshire won four of six at Harrisburg in 2023 (June 6-11) but lost four of six to the Senators earlier this year in Manchester.

**LATE OUT THE GATE:** New Hampshire began the second half with a trip to Hartford, a 3/3 series with Portland, and a six-game homestand against Binghamton. On the other side of those 16 games (two suspended to rain) is a 3-13 record after the All-Star Week. Entering the Harrisburg series, the team's .228 average and .647 OPS are both 10th of 12 in the league. NHFC pitchers hold a combined 4.82 ERA and a 1.16 WHIP, both second-highest in the EL.

**WHERE's THE BEEF?:** Garrett Spain still leads New Hampshire's roster with nine HRs this season. The Fisher Cats knocked 145 HRs to their opponent's mark of 138 in 2023, a team that was led by **Damiano Palmegiani** and Will Robertson with 19. The Cats opened 2024 with 10 home runs in 10 games, with four from Spain and two from 21-year-old **Gabby Martinez**.

**MAKE IT RAIN:** Rainer Nunez has been New Hampshire's most improved bat since mid-June. Rainer has recorded a hit in 16 of his last 18 since June 15, causing his batting average to jump from a .205 to a .254. Nunez has homered twice since July 1 and is 11-for-35 (.314) in the month with nine multi-hit games since the offensive turnaround began. After four doubles in his first 10 games, Nunez has five doubles since April 17.

**ON THIS DATE:** July 19, 2018 - The Fisher Cats rallied back from down 3-0 to beat the Harrisburg Senators at Delta Dental Stadium, 6-3. **Andrew Guillotte** (GEE-ott) singled home the go-ahead run in the seventh and **Bo Bichette** followed that with a two-run double. **Andrew Case** closed out his seventh save.

AROUND THE NEST: The Blue Jays (44-52), off a 6-3 West Coast swing, are back at Rogers Centre for nine games starting tonight with the Tigers. Toronto will also host Tampa Bay and Texas before playing Baltimore and the Yankees for 10 straight.... Like the Fisher Cats, Triple-A Buffalo (42-50) has had a tough start to July, going 3-9. The Bisons have a threegame series with Scranton Wilkes-Barre before hosting Syracuse next week... High-A Vancouver (46-38) is currently tied with first-half Northwest League champ Spokane atop the standings at 16-5. The teams were set to open a series Friday afternoon at Nat Bailey Stadium...Dunedin (45-41) plays at Lakeland this weekend.

**CESAR'S CHASE:** On June 28, the Fisher Cats defeated Hartford at Dunkin' Park, 3-1. With the win, manager **Cesar Martin** earned his 205th victory with the Fisher Cats to become New Hampshire's all-time winningest manager in franchise history (205-246). Former NH manager and current Hartford skip **Bobby Meacham** managed the Fisher Cats from 2014-2016 and wrapped up his three-year tenure with a record of 204-220.

**HALFTIME:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats ended the first half of 2024 with a 30-38 record and in last place of the Northeast Division. SS **Josh Kasevich** played in 60 of NH's 69 games in the first half and finished atop the Eastern League's hits list (79) and held the league's third-best BA (.306). Hartford won their final two games in Harrisburg to clinch.

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Eight Fisher Cat alums have made MLB debuts in 2024 with **IF Leo Jimenez** the most recent, debuting with the Blue Jays on 7/4. There have now been 165 players to make MLB debuts after playing with New Hampshire. Others to debut this year: RHP Yosver Zulueta (CIN, 6/25), OF Steward Berroa (TOR, 6/23), IF Orelvis Martinez (TOR 6/21), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (STL, 6/20) and LHP Brandon Eisert (TOR, 6/18), Addison Barger (TOR, 4/24) and Austin Martin (MIN, 3/30).
